August 28, 2017

- 1) Call to Order  
Meeting called to order at 7:03 pm
- 2) Roll Call
  - a) Isa Russel was absent, and Shivansh Srivastava was excused.
- 3) Minutes Approval
  - a) Travis Dobbin motioned to approve the minutes, and Rebecca Jackson seconded.
  - b) Minutes approved unanimously.
